Prevent the perlite from drying out. When they have sprouted, continue watering as before but alternate between plain water and a fertilizer mixture of 1 tsp. of 20-20-20 water-soluble fertilizer

For seed starting, you can use straight peat moss or blend it with perlite, sand, or vermiculite. For containers, you'll want to mix up your soil, peat moss, and even add some perlite or

Perlite or expanded polystyrene will be added to maintain optimal porosity. This contributes to the proper aeration of the potting soil, while keeping it light and porous.
